- **Training Domain/Location Column** – identifies the training location and the Leadership Domain (Institutional, Operational, or Self-Development) where the task is first trained to soldier training publications standards. If the task is first trained to standard in the training base, it will identify, by brevity code (S-D, INST), the resident course where the task was taught.
- **Sustainment Training Frequency Column** – indicates the recommended frequency at which the tasks should be trained to ensure soldiers maintain task proficiency.
- **Sustainment Training Skill Level Column** – lists the skill levels of the MOS for which soldiers must receive sustainment training to ensure they maintain proficiency to soldier’s manual standards.
