

## ART 2.3.2 Perform Intelligence, Surveillance, and Reconnaissance Integration

Intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance integration is the task of assigning and controlling a unit's intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance assets (in terms of space, time, and purpose) to collect and report information as a concerted and integrated portion of operation plans and orders. Intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance (ISR) integration assigns and controls a unit's ISR assets (in terms of space, time, and purpose) to collect and report information as a concerted and integrated portion of operation plans and orders. The operations officer integrates the best ISR assets through a deliberate and coordinated effort of the entire staff across all warfighting functions into the operation. Specific information requirements facilitate tasking by matching requirements to assets. Intelligence requirements are identified, prioritized, and validated. ISR integration is vital in controlling limited ISR assets. During ISR integration, the staff recommends redundancy, mix, and cue as appropriate. The result of ISR synchronization and integration is an effort focused on answering the commander's requirements. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
