

ART 7.1.1.1 Conduct a Meeting Engagement

A meeting engagement is a combat action that occurs when a moving force engages an enemy at an unexpected time and place. Such encounters normally occur by chance in small-unit operations, typically when two moving forces collide. They may result in brigade or larger unit operations when intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance operations have been ineffective. Meeting engagements can also occur when opposing forces are aware of the general presence, but not the exact location, of each other, and both decide to attack immediately. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
