

ART 4.1.3.3.2 Provide Packaged Petroleum, Oils, and Lubricants Products

Provide packaged products—including lubricants, greases, hydraulic fluids, compressed gasses, and specialty items—that are stored, transported, and issued in containers with a capacity of 55 gallons or less. (FM 10-67) (CASCOM)

01	Yes/No	Unit had class III supplies to conduct its mission.
02	Yes/No	Unit did not have to wait for packaged class III supplies before it could conduct its mission.
03	Yes/No	Spill planning and procedures related to environmental considerations were present and being followed.
04	Time	To refine the supply support program for an area of operations after receipt of warning order.
05	Time	Of operational delay due to fuel shortages.
06	Time	Of supply of required packaged petroleum products in place to support operations.
07	Percent	And type of daily class III packaged petroleum products provided by host nation.
08	Percent	And type of required packaged petroleum products delivered to theater.
09	Percent	Of packaged petroleum products deliveries completed compared to forecasted requirements.
10	Percent	Of attempted deliveries destroyed by enemy action.
11	Number	Of gallons per day and type of packaged petroleum products delivered to theater.
