

## ART 1.2.10 Navigate from One Point to Another

Use navigational aids, such as maps, compasses, charts, stars, dead reckoning, and global positioning system receivers. ART 1.2.10 includes determining distance; direction; location; elevation and altitude; route; and data for navigational aids, orientation, and rate of movement. (FM 3-25.26) (USAIS)

<b>NO.</b>	<b>Scale</b>	<b>Measure</b>
01	Yes/No	The unit was in the correct position at the correct time.
02	Time	To plan the movement of the individual, unit, vehicle, ship, or aircraft.
03	Time	Of force delays due to navigational error.
04	Percent	Of force no longer mission capable due to navigational error accidents.
05	Percent	Of force that arrives at the correct destination at the planned time.
