1. Direct the operation of the auxiliary power unit (APU).
 - a. Ensure the start-up is done correctly.
 - b. Ensure the shut-down is done correctly.
2. Direct the preparation of the hydraulic system for operations.
3. Direct the Opening and closing of the upper (ballistic shield) and lower rear doors.
 - a. Ensure the manual operation of the upper rear door is done correctly.
 - b. Ensure the hydraulic opening of the upper rear door is done safely and correctly.
 - c. Ensure the hydraulic closing of the upper rear door is done safely and correctly.
 - d. Ensure the closing the lower rear middle door is completed correctly.
4. Supervise the preparation of the conveyor for operation.

(Asterisks indicates a leader performance step.)

Evaluation Preparation: Setup: Ensure that all the equipment and assistants are available and ready for use. Brief soldier: Tell the soldier to direct the preparation of the M992 CAT for operation.

Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, NBC Protection, FM 3-11.5, CBRN Decontamination.
