

## ART 1.5.2 Occupy an Attack and Assault Position

As part of an offensive operation, move tactical forces into and through these positions to prepare for further action or support actions of another force. Activities include making last-minute coordination and tactical adjustments, preparing specialized equipment for immediate use, and protecting the occupying force until supporting fire is lifted or shifted. This task includes the use of attack-by-fire and support-by-fire positions and holding areas by attack helicopters. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)

NO.	Scale	Measure
01	Yes/No	Unit occupied attack and assault positions only as necessary to ensure the attack's success.
02	Yes/No	Unit cleared these positions of enemy forces.
03	Yes/No	The enemy did not surprise the unit main body.
04	Yes/No	All personnel and essential equipment moved into assigned positions by time specified in operation order.
05	Yes/No	Unit completed attack and assault preparations per commander's intent and the factors of mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available, time available, civil considerations.
