

ART 7.3.3.1 Provide Essential Civil Services

Army forces provide essential services, assets, or specialized resources to help civil authorities deal with situations beyond their capabilities. Activities of military forces to provide essential civil services are often defined in terms of the immediate humanitarian needs of the people: providing the food, water, shelter, and medical support necessary to sustain the population until local civil services are restored.

04	Yes/No	Unit established or reopened accessible clinics to deal with emergency health problems.
