**Condition:** Civilians have been, or are expected to be, driven from their homes by military operations, insurgents, or enemy forces in the area in which the element is operating. These dislocated civilians (DCs) could disrupt military operations and affect security. Insurgents may try to overthrow the host nation government and exploit the population. An element has been directed to provide support to a civil affairs element or to host nation agencies. The element will assist in populace and resource control by enforcing control measures and providing security within an assigned area of responsibility. Some iterations of this task should be performed in MOPP 4.

**Standard:** Support populace and resource control operations. The element enforces control measures that are necessary to provide security for the local population and their resources. DCs are assisted and protected while being diverted from routes and areas where they may interfere with military operations. DCs are treated according to the *Geneva Conventions* and agreements between the U.S. and the host nation. The time required to perform this task is increased when conducting it in mission-oriented protective posture ( MOPP) 4.

## TASK STEPS

\* 1. The element leader prepares to provide support to populace and resource control operations by initiating troop-leading procedures.

Note: Supporting populace and resource control operations is a difficult mission and elements must work closely with Civil Affairs to develop a workable plan to be successful. Plan is largely dependent on the size of the civilian population that the leaders and elements must contend with during the course of the mission. Prior planning and coordination is the key to success.

a. Conducts an estimate of the situation.

(1) Conducts a detailed mission analysis.

(2) Includes time for understanding and restating the mission.

(3) Uses the backward-planning sequence to schedule troop-leading procedures.

Note: For military police units only, leaders will consider police intelligence operations (PIO) when planning all MP operations. The PIO function represents MP capability to collect and process relevant information from many sources generally associated with policing activities or military police operations. As an integrating function, PIO describes an approach to all other MP functions that ensures their integration with all relevant police activities and organizations in the operations process and the AO.

b. Issues a warning order to all squads.

(1) Includes a mission statement (who, what, where, when, and why).

(2) Includes friendly and hostile situations.

(3) Includes general and special instructions.

c. Makes a tentative plan.

(1) Analyzes the mission using mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available, time available, civil considerations.

(2) Compares courses of action.

d. Coordinates with higher headquarters, civil affairs, or host nation agencies for additional requirements.

e. Coordinates with nongovernmental agencies (NGOs) and private volunteer organizations (PVOs) as needed.

f. Coordinates a map reconnaissance of the element's area of operations, at a minimum.

g. Coordinates with civil affairs to establish a traffic control plan.

h. Identifies main supply routes and road networks that can be affected by the high volume of DCs.

i. Determines the location of aid stations, assembly points, and food and water points established by the host nation.

j. Coordinates with higher headquarters to identify primary and alternate evacuation routes selected by host nation authorities for DCs.

k. Identifies sites for additional control measures, such as checkpoints and roadblocks.

l. Identifies key facilities, goods, and populations that need security.

m. Coordinates for logistical supplies to support the mission.

n. Coordinates for medical evacuation of DCs.

o. Coordinates for interpreters/translators.

p. Briefs element members on the following:

(1) The rules of engagement and rules for the use of force.

Note: Nonlethal tactics and capabilities are always supported, held in reserve, or overwatched by lethal capabilities.

(2) The requirements and restrictions of the Geneva Conventions and U.S. policies.

(3) The categories that DCs will be segregated into.

(4) Other US-host nation, IGOs, and NGOs agreements.

(5) Local customs and taboos.

\* 2. The element executes populace control measures.

Note: For military police units only, MP elements will integrate police information gathering by focusing on the variables of POLICE: police and prison structures, organized criminal networks, legal systems, investigations and interviews, crime conducive conditions, and enforcement gaps and mechanisms.

a. Identifies village and religious leaders.

b. Enforces curfews in DC camp or holding areas/controlled areas.

c. Enforces movement restrictions inside camps, holding areas/controlled areas.

d. Verifies licenses, travel permits and registration cards.

e. Assists with rescue and evacuation operations.

f. Assists with crowd control operations.

g. Resettles specific portions of the population as directed.

h. Treats DCs according to the Geneva Conventions and other U.S./host nation agreements.

i. Assists host nation elements in providing for the general safety of populace.

\* 3. The element executes resource control measures.

a. Establishes and operates roadblocks and checkpoints.

b. Controls rations.

c. Enforces local regulations and guidelines.

- d. Assists with amnesty programs.
- e. Provides security for infrastructure personnel conducting inspections of facilities.
- f. Uses biometrics, sensors, and other security equipment as required.

\* 4. The element executes DC control measures.

- a. Patrols selected routes.
- b. Establishes and operates roadblocks and checkpoints.
- c. Marks designated routes with signs to direct DCs.
- d. Diverts DCs to designated evacuation routes and away from routes and areas being used for military operations.
- e. Directs DCs to aid stations, assembly points, and food and water points established by the host nation or the U.S. military.
- f. Screens DCs to detect criminals, infiltrators, and enemy agents.
- g. Enforces control measures such as curfews, travel permits, and limits on personal belongings.
- h. Prevents unauthorized movement.
- i. Uses biometric devices to account for DCs, if available.

Note: The element may be required to collect, evacuate, and process DCs in collecting points and camps. The DCs should be handled in the same manner as enemy prisoners of war with regard to the difference in their status. The DCs are detained persons—not prisoners. The security personnel of the facility should not give the impression that it is a prison. For handling and processing DCs, refer to tasks describing treatment of detainees and civilian internees.

- j. Treats DCs according to the Geneva Conventions and other U.S./host nation agreements.

\* 5. The element leader monitors mission progress.

- a. Updates higher headquarters on mission status.
- b. Maintains a map overlay with current information, and submits it to higher headquarters, as required.

Note: For military police units only, compile police information, analyze for trends, patterns and associations within the platoon's area of operations and forward to higher headquarters.

- c. Ensures that all personnel are treated according to the Geneva Conventions and other U.S./host nation agreements.
- d. Plans for future operations.

Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, Multiservice Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Nuclear, Biological, and Chemical (NBC) Protection, FM 3-11.5, Multiservice Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear Decontamination. In a training environment, leaders must perform a risk assessment in accordance with FM 5-19, Composite Risk Management.
