Environment: 200-1 delineates TRADOC responsibilities to integrate environmental requirements across DOTMLPF and ensures all training procedures, training materials, and training doctrine include sound environmental practices and considerations. The Army's environmental standard is to be a national leader in environmental and natural resource stewardship for present and future generations as an integral part of all Army missions. This lesson meets this standard.

Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, NBC Protection, FM 3-11.5, CBRN Decontamination. cidents are an unacceptable impediment to Army missions, readiness, morale, and resources.
