

ART 7.1.1 Conduct a Movement to Contact

The movement to contact is an offensive action designed to develop the situation and establish or regain contact. Forces conducting a movement to contact seek to make contact with the smallest forces feasible. A movement to contact may result in a meeting engagement. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
