

ART 6.9.2.3.4 Support Weapons of Mass Destruction Monitoring and Redirection Activities

Monitoring and redirection includes actions to convert weapons of mass destruction (WMD) programs, personnel, sites, and facilities to prevent transfer, reconstitution, and misuse of residual dual-use capabilities. (ATTP 3-11.23) (USACBRNS)
