The section provides the developed annex to the operations staff for publication as part of the order IAW the commanders intent, the OPORD/FRAGORD, the unit SOP, and FM 5-0.

Leaders are the Collection Management Chief, Intelligence Plans Officer, Assistant S2, All Source Intelligence Technician, Geospatial Intelligence Technician, Intelligence Sergeant, and others designated by the commander.
