Performance Steps

1. Verify galley is staffed with qualified 92G (Food Service Specialist) as required by mission
 - a. Verify Galley Personnel are trained on emergency procedures and drills
 - b. Verify Galley Personnel are identified as swimmer or non swimmer
2. Inspect menu prepared by Food Service Specialist to ensure the following;
 - a. Ensure menu covers 30 days or length of mission
 - b. Ensure alternate meals are planned to accommodate for religious practices and alternative diets
 - c. Ensure meals contain all dietary needs
3. Purchase rations based on needs of the menu
4. Inspect Galley for the following
 - a. Valid Galley inspection performed by authorized agency
 - b. Inspect for cleanliness
 - c. Inspect stored rations ensuring rations are labeled properly and not expired

(Asterisks indicates a leader performance step.)

Evaluation Guidance: Score the soldier GO if all steps are passed (P). Score the soldier NO-GO if any steps is failed (F), if the soldier fails any step, show what was done wrong and how to do it correctly.

Evaluation Preparation: Ensure that all information, references and equipment required to perform the task are available. Use the FM and the evaluation guide to score the soldier's performance. Brief the soldier. Tell the soldier what he is required to do IAW the task conditions and standards.
