

## ART 2.1.1.2 Conduct Intelligence Readiness Operations

Intelligence readiness operations support contingency planning and preparation by developing baseline knowledge of multiple potential threats and operational environments. This information and training enables a collaborative effort and environment to provide the best possible initial threat understanding. (FM 2-0) (USAICoE)

NO.	Scale	Measure
01	Yes/No	Unit provided information on the civil considerations using the factors of areas, structures, capabilities, organizations, people and events affecting the force.
02	Percent	Of intelligence relating to the enemy force.
03	Percent	Of intelligence relating to potential terrorist acts against U.S. forces.
04	Percent	Of intelligence relating to potential insurgent, guerrilla, or criminal groups.
05	Percent	Of intelligence relating to using chemical, biological, radiological, nuclear, and high-yield explosives (CBRNE) weapons.
06	Percent	Of information and intelligence that facilitates a cultural understanding of the operational environment.
07	Percent	Of intelligence requirements to support the other warfighting functions or Army programs.
