

ART 1.2.1.4 Conduct a Penetration

A penetration is a maneuver in which an attacking force seeks to rupture enemy defenses on a narrow front to disrupt the defensive system. Commanders direct penetrations when enemy flanks are not assailable or time does not permit another form of maneuver. Successful penetrations create assailable flanks and provide access to enemy sustainment areas. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
