Performance Steps

1. Analyze a Current Religious Area Analysis (RAA) of the Area of Operations.
 - a. Determine Religions in the area of operations.
 - b. Locate number, education and influence of clergy.
 - c. Identify tenets of religion.
 - d. Determine relationships of religion with peoples, cultures and influences.
 - e. List socioeconomic influences of religions.
 - f. Determine Government/Religious Groups relations.
 - g. List any religious schools, sizes, and affiliations with nonreligious.
 - h. Identify mission impact.
2. Develop a Running Staff Estimate for Religious Support (RSE).
 - a. Gather facts and assumptions on the mission using the METT-TC format.
 - b. Analyze the BN Mission, the situation and courses of action for integration of Religious Support planning.
 - c. Analyze and compare courses of action and UMT role in support.
 - d. Recommendation for religious support in the CDR's chosen course of action.
3. Produce a Religious Support Plan (RSP).
 - a. Identify the Annex plan and series within the OPLAN.
 - b. Complete religious support plan matrix with current data.
4. Write the Religious Support Annex/TAB to the Battalion OPORD.
 - a. Transfer RSP matrix data to memorandum annex format.
 - b. Identify details in the memorandum with clarity and precision.
 - c. Check memorandum with BDE Chaplain for corrections.
 - d. Present completed memorandum to BN CDR/S3 for signature.
 - e. Modify Annex if necessary and submit to S3 for inclusion in OPORD

(Asterisks indicates a leader performance step.)

Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, Multiservice Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Nuclear, Biological, and Chemical (NBC) Protection, FM 3-11.5, Multiservice Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear Decontamination.
