The Army's Methodology for Training



CATS are task-based, event-driven training strategies based on the mission for which units are designed and provides:

- Task selections displaying a group of collective tasks trained together.
 - Supporting collective tasks with linked training & evaluation outlines (T&EOs).
 - Associated training events (FTX, classes, STX, STAFFEX).
- Synchronized with the Army's Progressive Readiness Model and Standards in Training Commission (STRAC).
- Table of organization and equipment (TOE) based and focused training on the unit's mission, employment, core capabilities, and functions.
- Provides the commander with "a way" to reach training proficiency.
- Accessed in Digital Training Management System (DTMS) and Army Training Network (ATN).

Facilities: Field Training Area

Purpose: To train the unit in the tasks associated with conducting an attack.

Outcome: The unit demonstrates proficiency in applying tactics, techniques, and procedures, SOP items, and tasks related to conducting an attack, in a live environment.

Execution Guidance: The battalion provides and/or coordinates for resources, to include observer/controllers, appropriate cues and responses, and an OPFOR. The OPFOR could be another platoon/company from the battalion conducting its own STX, e.g. defense. The scenario should provide for training on successfully maneuvering to and occupation of an attack position. The unit places effective direct fires and indirect fires on the enemy element, destroying it or causing it to withdraw. No friendly unit suffers casualties or equipment damage as a result of fratricide. The FIST should be fully integrated into the training in order to incorporate both direct fires and fire support. FBCB2/BFT should be trained to enhance situational awareness. Training is conducted during both day and night, and in various MOPP levels. More complex and challenging conditions should be included in the scenario in order to sustain and enhance training proficiency and readiness. All training should include improvised explosive devices (IEDs) awareness and identification. Task Selection: Provides a grouping of collective tasks trained together in one or more events. A number of Task Selections constitute a training strategy for a particular unit.

Frequency: Includes the recommended number of times the Task Selection should be trained during a Progressive Readiness Model Phase (PRMP).

Event: Provides a basis for assessing and evaluating unit readiness. They are designed to train Task Selections following a progressive (crawl, walk, run) methodology in order to build and sustain unit proficiency. Generally, each Task Selection has more than one event identified. The commander may select one or more events to achieve their desired end state.

Training Audience: Describes all units, elements, or individuals necessary to perform the Task Selection and ensure training can achieve the commander's desired end state and proficiency.

TADSS: Support the training event. TADSS identified within a training event assist the commander in mitigating limitations in maneuver space, density live fire ranges, and training facilities at home station.

Multiechelon Training: Identifies other Task Selections recommended to be performed by subordinate elements during this training.

Training Gates: Identifies training gates that should be achieved prior to training the Task Selection.

Purpose: Describes why this particular event was selected to train this Task Selection.

Outcome: Describes the end state of training by the unit as a result of training the Task Selection in the specified event.

Execution Guidance: Provides information for the commander to assist in determining the appropriate event to train a Task Selection and includes information to assist in the execution of the training.

Resources: Identifies approximate resource requirements to support the event for planning purposes. The commander may adjust the levels based on specific training objectives and local training conditions.
