Conditions: The commander receives an order from higher headquarters or derives a mission that requires the commander to issue guidance. The commander issues guidance in a dynamic and complex operational environment. Hybrid threat(s) contest unit objectives in all five domains (air, land, sea, space, and cyberspace), the information environment, and the electromagnetic spectrum. Additionally, they maintain the ability to sustain all eight forms of contact (visual; direct; indirect; non-hostile; obstacles; aircraft; chemical, biological, radiological, and nuclear (CBRN); and electronic) with the unit. All eight operational variables of PMESII-PT are present and dynamic for brigade and above, four or more for battalions. The order from higher headquarters includes all applicable overlays and or graphics, area of operation (AO) boundaries, control measures, and criteria for subsequent tactical actions. The command has communications with subordinate units, adjacent units, and higher headquarters. The commander has organized the four components of the command and control system to support decision making, facilitate communication, and conduct operations.

Note: Conduct the task using mission partner network (MPN) for foreign-partner information-sharing or conduct the operation as if foreign partners are on the network, realistically portraying an environment where the Army will likely conduct operations in a combined theater. Produce orders, estimates, and other staff products on the SECRET//RELEASABLE (S//REL) network while retaining non-releasable or not releasable to foreign nationals (NOFORN) information on the secret internet protocol router network (SIPRNET). Deployed units regularly operate mission-specific multinational information networks, and the Army will soon migrate most operations and training to the Releasable Training Environment (R-TE).

Environment: Some iterations of this task should be performed with degraded command and control networks, degraded conditions in the electromagnetic spectrum, and/or degraded, denied, and disrupted space operations environment (D3SOE). Standard MOPP 4 conditions do not exist for this task. See the MOPP 4 statement for specific conditions.

Standards: The commander issues guidance in accordance with (IAW) FM 5-0, established timelines, the commander's intent, orders from higher headquarters, the Army Ethic, and standard operating procedures (SOP), while adhering to the GO / NO-GO criteria without error.

Task Statements

Performance Steps

1. The commander issues initial guidance upon receipt of mission, to include:
 - Initial time allocations.
 - Guidance on the planning approach (initiate Army Design Methodology (ADM), conduct the full Military Decision-Making Process (MDMP), or conduct Rapid Decision-Making Synchronization Process (RDSP)).
 - Necessary coordination to perform, including liaison officers (LNOs) to exchange.
 - Authorized movements to initiate.
 - Information collection guidance, including reconnaissance and surveillance instructions.
 - Initial information requirements.
 - Additional staff tasks.

2. The commander issues guidance during the conduct of the ADM (assess only if the commander elects to conduct the ADM).
 - a. Issues guidance while framing the operational environment (OE), including:
 - Determining depth of complexity & detail required for consideration of the operational variables.
 - Envisioning desired end state.
 - Questioning assumptions.
 - Documenting the operational frame.

 - b. Issues guidance while framing the problem(s), including:
 - Determining complexity of the problem.
 - Identifying obstacles impeding progress toward achieving the desired end state.
 - Mapping relationship between problems.
 - Restating poorly framed problems as needed.
 - Applying the four ways of seeing a problem IAW ATP 5-0.1, Ch. 3.
 - Documenting the problem frame.

 - c. Issues guidance while framing a solution through development of an operational approach, including:
 - Determining centers of gravity (COGs).
 - Identifying decisive points (DPs).
 - Determining whether to take a direct or indirect approach.
 - Establishing objectives and devising lines of operations (LOOs) and lines of effort (LOEs).
 - Refining the operational approach.
 - Documenting the operational approach.

3. The commander gives planning guidance after mission analysis.

 - Priority intelligence requirements (PIR).
 - Terrain and weather factors.
 - Information collection guidance.
 - Possible information gaps.
 - Most likely and most dangerous enemy courses of action (COAs).
 - Enemy COA against which to conduct war game.
 - Most critical terrain and weather factors.
 - Most critical local environment and civil considerations.
 - Intelligence requests for information.
 - Intelligence focus during phased operations.
 - Desired enemy perception of friendly forces.

c. Movement and maneuver WFF:

- Initial commander's intent: purpose, key tasks, and the desired end state.
- COA development guidance, including specified COAs to consider (or to avoid) during planning.
- Number of COAs to consider or not consider.
- Critical events.
- Task organization (TO).
- Task and purpose of subordinate units.
- Forms of maneuver.
- Reserve composition, mission, priorities, and control measures.
- Security and counter reconnaissance.
- Friendly DPs.
- Branches and sequels.
- Task and direct collection.
- Military deception (MILDEC).
- Risk to friendly forces.
- Collateral damage or civilian casualties.
- Any condition that affects achievement of end state.
- Information operations (IO).
- COA evaluation criteria and weighting.

d. Fires WFF:

- Synchronization and focus of fires with maneuver.
- Priority of fires.
- High priority targets (HPTs).
- Special munitions.
- Target acquisition zones.
- Observer plan.

e. Protection WFF:

4. The commander issues guidance when approving a COA, Including:

- Approved COA (with any refinements).
- DPs.
- Branches/sequels requiring additional planning.
- Preparation and rehearsal guidance.
- Final timeline.

Note: Steps 5 and 6 below are included in this task to emphasize that giving guidance is embedded in the C2 WFF and to emphasize to commanders to utilize the principles of command and control throughout operations.

5. The commander provides guidance while applying the principles of C2 throughout the operations process.

- The commander builds cohesive teams through mutual trust (150-LDR-5001).
- The commander creates shared understanding (150-LDR-5007).
- The commander provides clear commander's intent (150-LDR-5004).
- The commander exercises initiative (150-LDR-5006).
- The commander uses mission order technique (150-LDR-5003).
- The commander identifies risk (150-LDR-5002).

6. The commander drives the operations process activities of planning, preparing, executing, and assessing through the activities of understanding, visualizing, describing, directing, leading, and assessing operations.

a. The commander continually leads the unit throughout the operations process (150-LDR-5015).

(1) The commander leads the unit team to a common understanding of the nature of the operation by approving the problem frame, operational environment frame, and operational approach.

(2) The commander leads the unit team to visualize the operation through planning guidance, initial intent, and COA approval.

(3) The commander leads the unit team to describe the operation through clear commander's intent and concept of operations.

(4) The commander leads the unit team by directing the operation through orders dissemination and the rapid decision-making and synchronization process (RDSP).

(5) The commander leads the unit team to assess progress of the operation according to established measures of effectiveness (MOE).

b. The commander takes actions to motivate and inspire subordinate commanders, the staff, and Soldiers to give maximum effort to accomplish the mission.

c. The commander listens to subordinate commanders, the staff, and Soldiers whenever possible in order to encourage collaboration and dialogue that increase understanding.

(1) The commander encourages critical and creative thinking, when appropriate.

(2) The commander conducts battlefield circulation to connect with subordinates and Soldiers.

7. The commander continually assesses the guidance:

- Monitors the current situation to collect relevant information.
- Evaluates progress toward attaining end state conditions, achieving objectives, and performing tasks.
- Recommends or direct action for improvement.
- Uses brief backs and rehearsals to determine whether guidance is clearly understood by subordinates.
- Continues task as required.

Note: Assessment is continuous; it precedes and guides every operations process activity and concludes each operation or phase of an operation.

(Asterisks indicates a leader performance step.)

Evaluation Guidance: Score the Soldier GO if he/she passes all performance measures. Score the Soldier NO-GO if Soldier fails any performance measure. If the Soldier scores NO-GO, show the Soldier why he/she failed and show the Soldier how to perform the measure correctly.

Evaluation Preparation: Brief the Soldier: Explain expectations to the Soldier by reviewing the task standards. Stress to the Soldier the importance of observing all cautions and warnings to avoid injury to personnel and, if applicable, damage to equipment.

In doing so, you will contribute to the sustainment of our training resources while protecting people and the environment from harmful effects.
