ART 7.1.2.5 Conduct a Feint

A feint is a form of attack used to deceive the enemy as to the location or time of the actual decisive operation. Forces conducting a feint seek direct fire contact with the enemy but avoid decisive engagement. Feints divert attention from the decisive operation and prevent the enemy from focusing elements of combat power against it. They are usually shallow, limited-objective attacks conducted before or during the decisive operation. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
