

ART 2.1.1 Provide Intelligence Readiness

Intelligence readiness operations develop baseline knowledge of multiple potential threats and operational environments. These operations support ongoing operations, contingency planning, and operational preparation. These operations and related intelligence training activities enable the intelligence warfighting function to support the commander's intelligence requirements effectively. (FM 2-0) (USAICoE)

01	Yes/No	Unit provided indications and warning reports.
02	Yes/No	Unit provided intelligence readiness.
03	Yes/No	Unit conducted foundry training.
04	Percent	Of intelligence relating to indications and warning prior to incident occurring.
05	Percent	Of relevant data, information, intelligence, and products received on the operational environment.
06	Percent	Of relevant training received for the conduct of operations.
