

ART 1.2.1.3 Conduct an Infiltration

An infiltration is a maneuver in which an attacking force conducts undetected movement through or into an area occupied by enemy forces to occupy a position of advantage while exposing only small elements to enemy defensive fires. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)

Note: Infiltration is also a tactical march technique used within a friendly territory to move forces in small groups at extended or irregular intervals. (See FM 3-90.)
