

### ART 7.3.3.3 Assist Dislocated Civilians

Army units assist dislocated civilians and continually assess numbers, locations, and needs of dislocated civilians as well as available support capacity such as host-nation organizations, nongovernmental organizations, relief supplies, physical transport, distribution, and storage. When needed, Army units help transport dislocated civilians, provide information, distribute water and food, and provide emergency medical assistance and locations for protection or humanitarian assistance. (ATP 3-07.5) (USAPKSOI)

09	Time	To develop policy for providing minimum essential support requirements to dislocated civilians.
10	Time	To establish policy for final disposition of dislocated civilians to include guidelines for their release to return to their homes and transition of U.S. control over their camps to host-nation, multinational, and nongovernmental organizations.
