+ 1. The company element leader prepares to conduct critical site security by initiating troop-leading procedures.

- a. Conducts an estimate of the situation.
  - (1) Conducts a detailed mission analysis.
  - (2) Includes time for understanding and restating the mission.
  - (3) Uses the backward-planning sequence to schedule troop-leading procedures.

Note: All military police conducting military police operations collect police information in accordance with the police information collection plan. Leaders must consider police intelligence operations (PIO) when planning and conducting all military police operations. The PIO function represents MP capability to collect, analyze, process, and disseminate relevant information that enhances situational understanding, protection, civil control and law enforcement activities.

- b. Issues a warning order to subordinate leaders and other key personnel.
  - (1) Includes a mission statement (who, what, where, when, and why).
  - (2) Includes friendly and hostile situations.
  - (3) Includes general and special instructions.
- c. Makes a tentative plan.
  - (1) Conducts analysis using mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available, time available, civil considerations (METT-TC).
  - (2) Compares courses of action.
- d. Reviews the existing security measures.
- e. Receives updated threat information from the military intelligence element.
- f. Conducts a reconnaissance of the routes to the critical site and areas around it and obtains SIGACTS, INTSUM, etc.
- g. Identifies vulnerabilities based on the latest assessment and observation and fields of fire, avenues of approach, key terrain, obstacles and movement, cover and concealment.
- h. Coordinates with site operations personnel concerning movement routes and security.
- i. Coordinates with higher headquarters or site operations personnel for tactical response force support, map overlays, and a threat analysis.
- j. Develops a communications plan.
- k. Makes a contingency plan for augmentation forces.
- l. Conducts a leader's reconnaissance with subordinate leaders, and develops security plans according to METT-TC and observation, concealment and cover, obstacles, key terrain, and avenues of approach.
- m. Develops a casualty evacuation plan.
- n. Briefs higher headquarters and/or site operations personnel on the security plan.
- o. Briefs the mission to the platoon.
- p. Ensures rehearsals are conducted IAW SOP.

+ 2. The subordinate leaders coordinate for support requirements.

- a. Coordinates for logistical requirements, to include:
  - (1) Rations and water.
  - (2) Ammunition.
  - (3) Petroleum, oil, and lubricants.
  - (4) Chemical lights.
  - (5) Additional communications equipment, as required by the mission.
  - (6) Barrier material.
  - (7) Specialized equipment such as remote sensors, biometrics, and other available security equipment, as required by the mission.
  - (8) Lethal and nonlethal ammunition and control agents, as authorized and available.
- b. Coordinates for military working dog support.
- c. Coordinates with site operations personnel for access control rosters, procedures, badges, and other security requirements.
- d. Develops load plans for vehicles and equipment requirements for personnel.
- e. Develops duty schedules and sleep plans for personnel, to include augmentation forces.

Note: Augmentation forces may be used to assist in perimeter defense, provide access control, operate dismount points, and augment and relieve primary security personnel.

- f. Obtains and establishes a challenge and password, a duress system (from ANCD), and a security badge control system.
- g. Provides oversight of subordinate leaders conducting pre-combat checks and inspections and conducts spot-checks.
- h. Determines the priority of work.

- i. Coordinates with higher headquarters for additional support (barrier placement, medical evacuation, UAS support, etc.).
- j. Ensures that primary and alternate communications are established.
- k. Maintains consistent communications with operations section to facilitate mission changes and requirements.

+ 3. The element conducts security of the critical site.

- a. Conducts mobile patrols in the vicinity of the site.
  - (1) Conducts area reconnaissance and surveillance to provide early warning of enemy activity and likely enemy avenues of approach to the site.
  - (2) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.
- b. Operates a checkpoint to provide standoff distance between vehicular traffic and the site.
  - (1) Screens and or searches vehicles approaching the site.
  - (2) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.
- c. Operates listening posts and observation posts outside the perimeter.
  - (1) Maintains cover and concealment.
  - (2) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.
- d. Coordinates UAS support, if available.
- e. Conducts perimeter security at the site.
  - (1) Maintains cover and concealment.
  - (2) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.
- f. Operates a dismount point near the entrance of the site.
  - (1) Screens all persons desiring access to the site.
  - (2) Allows access to authorized persons only.
  - (3) Directs vehicles into authorized parking areas, and maintains dispersion of vehicles (as applicable).
  - (4) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.
  - (5) Maintains an access control roster.
- g. Conducts sally port operations.
  - (1) Conducts vehicle searches.
  - (2) Conducts personnel and parcel searches.
- h. Provides access control and security for all designated facilities at the site.
  - (1) Allows access to authorized persons only.
  - (2) Maintains an access control roster and a security badge control system.
  - (3) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.
- i. Provides a response force to augment security, as required.
  - (1) Maintains the specified security, as required.
  - (2) Maintains communications with the element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.

Note: The situation and availability of personnel will dictate the size of the response force. Additional security may be required if more than one site is being secured.

+ 4. The subordinate leaders direct critical site security operations.

- a. Develops standing operating procedures for each position and operation, to include the response force.
- b. Controls the maneuver of elements and their rate and distribution of fire.
- c. Keeps the element leader informed of mission status throughout the operation.
- d. Integrates the rules of engagement and/or rules of interaction into the plan.

Note: Nonlethal tactics and capabilities are always supported, held in reserve, or overwatched by lethal capabilities.

- e. Maintains communications with element headquarters and/or site operations personnel.

+ 5. The element leader monitors mission progress.

**Environment:** Environmental protection is not just the law but the right thing to do. It is a continual process and starts with deliberate planning. Always be alert to ways to protect our environment during training and missions. In doing so, you will contribute to the sustainment of our training resources while protecting people and the environment from harmful effects. Refer to the current Environmental Considerations manual and the current GTA Environmental-related Risk Assessment card. .

**Safety:** In a training environment, leaders must perform a risk assessment in accordance with current Risk Management Doctrine. Leaders will complete the current Deliberate Risk Assessment Worksheet in accordance with the TRADOC Safety Officer during the planning and completion of each task and sub-task by assessing mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available-time available and civil considerations, (METT-TC). Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW current CBRN doctrine.
