Conditions: A military police brigade is deployed and is conducting operations. The chaplain, as a special and/or personal staff officer, assists the commander to meet the religious support requirements of assigned U.S. military personnel, serves as the principal advisor on the religious needs of detainees, and works with command personnel to foster humane treatment of detainees. Religious support comprises those activities that support observance of faith practices, pastoral care, and faith development. The unit ministry team (UMT) is directed to provide religious support. *Department of the Army (DA) Form 4237-R (Detainee Personnel Record)* is available. This task should not be trained in MOPP 4.

Standards: The brigade coordinates religious support for I/R operations. The brigade UMT provides unit personnel with religious support consistent with free-exercise provisions of the Constitution of the United States, Department of Defense policy, and service manuals. The UMT ensures that detainees, U.S. military prisoners, and U.S. Soldiers assigned to or attached to the brigade or battalion have opportunities to practice their religion. The applicable portions of the Geneva Conventions apply. The time required to complete this task is increased when conducting it in mission-oriented protective posture (MOPP) 4.

In doing so, you will contribute to the sustainment of our training resources while protecting people and the environment from harmful effects. Refer to the current Environmental Considerations manual and the current GTA Environmental-related Risk Assessment card. .

Safety: In a training environment, leaders must perform a risk assessment in accordance with current Risk Management Doctrine. Leaders will complete the current Deliberate Risk Assessment Worksheet in accordance with the TRADOC Safety Officer during the planning and completion of each task and sub-task by assessing mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available-time available and civil considerations, (METT-TC). Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW current CBRN doctrine.
