

ART 7.1.2.3 Conduct a Counterattack

A counterattack is an attack by part or all of a defending force against an attacking force with the general objective of denying attackers their goals. Commanders normally conduct counterattacks from a defensive posture. They direct them to defeat or destroy enemy forces or to regain control of terrain and facilities after enemy successes. They counterattack after enemies launch an attack, reveal their main effort, or offer an assailable flank. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
