SUBJECT: Approval of the System Training Plan (STRAP) Waiver for the Squad Portable Entry Control Kit (SPECK), Capability Production Document (CPD)

1. Reference:

- a. Squad Portable Entry Control Kit (SPECK), Capability Production Document (CPD), dated 23 January 2014.
- b. US Army Training and Doctrine Command Regulation 350-70, Army Learning Policy and Systems, 6 December 2011, paragraph 8-3-c-2(d), System training development interface.

2. Systems Training Plan Waiver for the SPECK is approved.

3. This waiver is to support the program for the Milestone C decision. The SPECK was developed as a consolidated, portable, and standardized tool kit to meet Entry Control Point (ECP) mission requirements. Equipment contained within the SPECK is comprised of commercial and government off-the-shelf technologies. World Wide Staffing (WWS) provided verification that no other Centers of Excellence (CoE) require Institutional Training.

4. The majority of equipment within the SPECK, have approved Graphic Training Aids. Any new equipment that may be developed will require the development of GTA's during the development of the actual device. The CPD addresses the requirement for the training aids to be developed during the development of products being placed in the SPECK.
