

### ART 7.6.3.1.1 Conduct Observation

Observation missions are performed primarily by unarmed military observers but may also be performed by peacekeeping forces. In either case, observers forces help ensure that parties to the dispute follow the agreements. (FM 3-07.31) (CASCOM)

| NO. | Scale  | Measure   |
|-----|--------|---|
| 01  | Yes/No | Unit established observation posts, mounted and dismounted patrols, and aerial reconnaissance.  |
| 02  | Yes/No | Unit observed, monitored, verified, and reported any alleged violation of the governing agreements.   |
| 03  | Yes/No | Unit confirmed or supervised a cease-fire.  |
| 04  | Yes/No | Unit investigated alleged cease-fire violations, boundary incidents, and complaints. The observer force investigated alleged infractions to gain evidence regarding agreement violations. |
| 05  | Yes/No | Unit conducted regular liaison visits in the area of operations.  |
| 06  | Yes/No | Unit planned for uncooperative local officials, demonstrations, and other forms of civil disturbance preventing mission accomplishment.   |
| 07  | Time   | To verify the storage or destruction of certain categories of military equipment specified in the relevant agreements.  |
