Performance Steps

CAUTION

Upper rear small doors must be opened and upper rear door must be closed before backing up to an M109A6. Failure to do so may result in damage to upper rear door.

- 1. Load Ammunition onto storage racks.
 - a. Open side door.
 - b. Load projectiles into the M992.
 - c. Stow projectiles on the projectile rack.
 - (1) Unlock a rack section.
 - (2) Secure rack handles.
 - (3) Load projectiles one at a time.
 - (4) Lock the rack section.
 - d. Load propelling charges into designated storage area.
 - (1) Open storage compartment.
 - (2) Loosen straps and bars.
 - (3) Load propelling charge canisters.
 - (4) Secure straps and bars over the propelling charge canisters.
 - (5) Close storage compartment.
 - e. Load 0.50-caliber ammunition boxes, fuse boxes, and primer boxes into designated storage areas.
- 2. Perform 'Loading' procedures in reverse to unload munitions.

(Asterisks indicates a leader performance step.)

Evaluation Preparation: Setup: Ensure that all the equipment and assistants are ready and available for use. Ensure that the support vehicle and/or M992 is loaded with ammunition (service or inert).

Brief Soldier: Tell the soldier to transfer the projectiles from the howitzer and/or support vehicle to the M992 or from the M992 to the howitzer and/or support vehicle to the howitzer.

Leaders will complete a DA Form 7566 COMPOSITE RISK MANAGEMENT WORKSHEET during the planning and completion of each task and sub-task by assessing mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available-time available and civil considerations, (METT-TC). Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, NBC Protection, FM 3-11.5, CBRN Decontamination. When handling ammunition, use gloves and ensure soldiers are aware of the weight consideration.
