

## ART 7.1.2.1 Conduct an Ambush

An ambush is an attack by lethal or nonlethal means from concealed positions on a moving or temporarily halted enemy. An ambush stops, denies, or destroys enemy forces by maximizing the element of surprise. Ambushes can employ direct fire systems as well as other destructive means, such as command-detonated mines, indirect fires, and supporting nonlethal fires. They may include an assault to close with and destroy the enemy forces. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)
