

ART 2.3.3.5 Conduct a Reconnaissance Patrol

Use a detachment of ground, sea, or air forces to gather information about the enemy, terrain, or civil environment. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)

NO.	Scale	Measure
01	Yes/No	Patrol collected the information required.
02	Yes/No	Unit prepared patrol plan within time allowed.
03	Yes/No	Unit conducted rehearsals to standard within the time allowed.
04	Yes/No	Patrol used tactically appropriate reconnaissance tactic-fan, converging route, or successive bounds.
05	Yes/No	Enemy detected reconnaissance patrol.
06	Yes/No	Information observed or gained from contact with the local population (Soldier surveillance and reconnaissance) by units conducting a reconnaissance patrol was collected by debriefing Soldiers or from unit reports.
07	Time	To conduct the reconnaissance patrol by time allocated by higher headquarters.
08	Percent	Of assigned area covered during the patrol.
09	Percent	Of tactical-level requirements satisfied by higher or adjacent units' existing intelligence, surveillance, and reconnaissance assets on a noninterference basis.
10	Percent	Of accuracy of data provided.
11	Percent	Of friendly casualties received during the combat patrol.
12	Percent	Of information requirements achieved.
