### Performance Steps

1. Coordinate maintenance support for theater mortuary affairs evacuation point.
  - a. HVAC and refrigeration
  - b. Vehicle
  - c. Building
2. Coordinate communication support with supporting S-6 for:
  - a. NIPR/ FAX/Scanner/ phone and email.
  - b. SIPR
3. Coordinate the nearest EOD unit in the event remains arrive with UXO or other ordinance that needs removal.
4. Coordinate with the behavioral health department to provide counseling/treatment for MACP Soldiers experiencing issues.
5. Coordinate with Chaplain to provide any necessary religious rites and support of team members.
6. Coordinate for Bio and hazardous waste removal with either the medical treatment facility or host nation contractor.
7. Coordinate with the supporting unit or installation to provide resupply of all administrative and supplies to include office machines (copier, fax, computers, ect).
8. Coordinate with the theater mortuary affairs office (TMAO) for additional refrigeration in the event of a mass fatality.
9. Coordinate with the medical treatment facility for:
  - a. Medical needs of the team
  - b. Medical doctor to available for initiation of DD form 2064 Certificate of Death Overseas.
  - c. Resupply of personal protective equipment (PPE).
10. Coordinate with Occupational health/preventive medicine to support MA personnel and establish procedures for accessing that capability. This includes direction on proper maintenance and care of PPE and respiratory protection program requirements. The individuals may also be required to control insect or vermin infestations at TMEP site.

Leaders will complete a DA Form 7566 COMPOSITE RISK MANAGEMENT WORKSHEET during the planning and completion of each task and sub-task by assessing mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available-time available and civil considerations, (METT-TC). Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, Multiservice Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Nuclear, Biological, and Chemical (NBC) Protection, FM 3-11.5, Multiservice Tactics, Techniques, and Procedures for Chemical, Biological, Radiological, and Nuclear Decontamination.
