

ART 6.11.1.2 Apply Appropriate Operations Security Measures

Deny adversaries information about friendly capabilities and intentions by identifying, controlling, and protecting indicators associated with planning and conducting military operations. (FM 3-13) (USACAC)

NO.	Scale	Measure
01	Yes/No	Unit application of OPSEC measures prevented the enemy from detecting the correct indicators of friendly operations until it was too late for the enemy to react.
02	Yes/No	Units changed patterns of operation on an irregular basis.
03	Time	To apply appropriate OPSEC measures.
04	Time	To brief unit information operations cell and unit plans cell on OPSEC requirements.
05	Time	To identify target sets and desired effect, by priority.
06	Percent	Of OPSEC surveys reflected in OPSEC plans.
07	Percent	Of routine actions with timing or location changed at least weekly.
08	Percent	Of favorable signal security assessments.
09	Number	Of public media disclosures.
10	Number	Of critical EEFI that must be concealed from the enemy.
