

ART 1.2.1.1.3 Conduct an Amphibious Assault

The Army conducts an amphibious assault as a member of the landing force in conducting one of four forcible entry operations. It may also conduct forcible entry operations via airborne, air assault or a combination of any or all of these forcible entry techniques. An amphibious assault secures a defensible beachhead from which to conduct lodgment activities. This mission begins when Soldiers and equipment leave the ships that bring them to the amphibious objective area and transfer to the landing craft that will deliver them to the beach. The mission ends when all elements of the amphibious force are delivered onto the beachhead and the assault objective has been seized. (JP 3-02) (USJFCOM JWFC)

Note: Army forces follow joint doctrine and Marine Corps doctrinal publications when tasked to conduct amphibious operations. Scale and measures assigned to ART 1.2.1.1.1 apply.
