

ART 6.6.1 Identify Potential Terrorist Threats and Other Threat Activities

Enhance freedom of action by identifying and reducing friendly vulnerability to terrorist threats, acts, influence, or surprise. This includes measures to protect from surprise, observation, detection, interference, espionage, terrorism, and sabotage. This task includes actions for protecting and securing the flanks and sustainment area of operational formations, and protecting and securing critical installations and facilities.(ATTP 3-39.32) (USAMPS)
