

ART 1.5.1 Occupy an Assembly Area

Move forces into and occupy an assembly area in which to assemble and prepare for further action. Actions include resupplying and organizing forces for future operations. (FM 3-90) (USACAC)

NO.	Scale	Measure
01	Yes/No	Unit moved into and occupied an assembly area in which it assembles and prepares for further action by time specified in operation order.
02	Yes/No	Unit forced enemy reconnaissance elements to withdraw without allowing penetration of the assembly area perimeter.
03	Yes/No	The enemy did not surprise the unit main body through a failure to conduct security operations.
04	Yes/No	Unit dispersed its forces appropriately; used cover and concealment; and designated entrances, exits, and internal routes per the factors of mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available, time available, civil considerations to include drainage and soil conditions per environmental considerations.
05	Yes/No	All personnel and essential equipment moved into assigned initial defensive positions by time specified in operation order.
06	Yes/No	Unit completed preparations for next operation per commander's intent by time specified in operation order.
