

ART 5.8.1.1 Perform Law Enforcement

Law enforcement (LE) are those activities performed by personnel authorized by legal authority to compel compliance with, and investigate violations of, laws, directives, and punitive regulations. LE occurs in support of governance and the rule of law; for LE to occur, a legal system must exist. Typically, LE is performed by personnel trained as police officers who are held directly accountable to the governmental source of their authority. (FM 3-39) (USAMPS)
