

## ART 7.4 Conduct Civil Support Operations

Civil support is Department of Defense support to U.S. civil authorities for domestic emergencies, and for designated law enforcement and other activities (JP 3-28). Civil support includes operations that address the consequences of natural or manmade disasters, accidents, and incidents within the United States and its territories. Army forces conduct civil support operations when the size and scope of events exceed the capabilities of domestic civilian agencies. The Army National Guard is often the first military force to respond on behalf of state authorities. Army civil support operations include three tasks: provide support in response to a disaster, support civil law enforcement, and provide other support as required.
