ART 5.1 Conduct the Operations Process

The operations process consists of the major mission command activities performed during operations: planning, preparing, executing, and continuously assessing the operation. The commander drives the operations process through leadership. The activities of the operations process may be sequential

or simultaneous. They are usually not discrete; they overlap and recur as circumstances demand. Commanders use the operations process to help them decide when and where to make decisions, control operations, and provide command presence. (USACAC)
