Condition: As an Air Traffic Controller assigned to an ATC facility, given reported or observed airport conditions that affect the safe use of the landing area, and appropriate manuals. Some iterations of this task should be performed in MOPP.

Standard: Issues all airport conditions that will have adverse affects on the safe operation of aircraft in time for it to be useful to the pilot IAW FAAO JO 7110.65.

Cue: You receive, or observe airport conditions that affect the safe use of the landing area.

Notes: The airport management or military operations office is responsible observing and reporting the condition of the landing area. The agency operating the airport is responsible for providing the tower with current information about airport conditions.

Performance Steps

1. Issue the condition of the landing area to the pilot IAW FAAO 7110.65, Chapter (Ch) 3, Section (Sec) 3.

2. Issue closed/unsafe runway information to aircraft requesting takeoff on closed/unsafe runway IAW FAAO JO 7110.65, Ch 3, Sec 3.

3. Issue timely airport condition information necessary for the safe operation of an aircraft IAW FAAO JO 7110.65, Ch 3, Sec 3.

4. Issue the quality of braking action as received from pilots or airport management to all aircraft.

5. Issue braking action advisories.

(Asterisks indicates a leader performance step.)

Evaluation Preparation: Setup: This task should be done in an actual environment but may be simulated by the supervisor. Provide the Soldier with the airport condition information. The weather condition is required to be (or simulated to be) below basic VFR conditions. Have the Soldier perform (or simulate performing) all Performance Steps IAW FAAO JO 7110.65. Brief Soldier: Tell the Soldier he/she will be evaluated on their ability to Issue Airport Condition Information consistent with the Performance Steps contained within this Task. This requirement includes using the correct phraseology as stated in IAW FAAO JO 7110.65.

Note: During MOPP training, leaders must ensure personnel

are monitored for potential heat injury. Local policies and procedures must be followed during times of increased heat category in order to avoid heat related injury. Consider the MOPP work/rest cycles and water replacement guidelines IAW FM 3-11.4, NBC Protection, FM 3-11.5, CBRN Decontamination. Everyone is responsible for safety. A thorough risk assessment must be completed prior to every mission or operation. Leaders must perform a risk assessment in accordance with FM 5-19, Composite Risk Management. Leaders will complete a DA Form 7566 COMPOSITE RISK MANAGEMENT WORKSHEET during the planning and completion of each task and sub-task by assessing mission, enemy, terrain and weather, troops and support available-time available and civil considerations, (METT-TC).
